Language Arts:

This week we are learning all about the letter f (as in fan and fun). We will also be learning the word you. Last week we read "The Gruffalo" and the students enjoyed reading about the clever mouse. This week we will work on retelling the story and talk about the characters and setting.

Guided Reading (small groups reading books at their DRA level) is under way!! In our groups, students were introduced to Eagle Eye and Stretchy Snake. These characters help students decode words that they are unsure of. Eagle Eye tells you to look at your picture and Stretchy Snake tells you to slowly say the sounds. When reading book bags at home, encourage your child to use these strategies to solve words.

<u>Math:</u>

In math we will continue to work on addition. We have spent lots of time working on our five facts (1+4, 2+3, etc.) and have begun to work on our 10 facts (1+9, 2+8, etc.). Students are beginning to write number sentences using an addition sign and an equal sign. We are also working on using pictures to solve addition word problems.
