Language Arts:

This week it is all about the letter i (as in igloo) . . . how to write it, what it sounds like and words that begin with it. We will also continue learning sight words– here.

This week we will also continue to work on positional words (above, below, under, behind, in front) as we create a book– *Hide Turkey Hide!*

Math:

Our focus this week in math will be on the number 8. We will do all things 8 related. Students will be counting forwards and backwards to 8. They will count objects in groups of eight, saying only one number as they touch each object.

Later this week we will begin comparing numbers, talking about greater than and less than. As we begin this unit of study, students will be using hands on manipulatives to compare numbers (connecting unifix cubes and seeing which one is taller).
