Language Arts:

This week we are learning all about the letter j (as in juice and jump). We will also continue to review all of the letters previously learned (c, o, a, d, g, m, l, h, i, t). Students will begin to stretch out 3 letter words and write down the sounds they hear (dog, him, cat). They will be coming home excited about the words they can spell. Please build upon their excitement and give them new words to practice– any three letter words you can build with the letters above.

This week we will begin our Gingerbread Man unit. Over the next three weeks, we will read a variety of Gingerbread stories and compare and contrast them. Students will write their own Gingerbread Man book and use their 5 senses to explore gingerbread. Our unit will culminate with our own Gingerbread Man hunt at Wilde!!

Math:

Our focus this week in math will be on the number 9. We will be counting, writing and making combinations of 9. We will also continue to compare numbers through a variety of games. You can help your child at home with this by giving them a small handful of items and asking them which one has more or which one has less (ex: are there more pennies or dimes?) Students will make a guess and then line up each item to see which has more.
