Language Arts:

This week it is all about the letter h (as in house and horse) . . . how to write it, what it sounds like and words that begin with it. We will also continue learning sight words– play. Please review all of our letters and sight words at home (c, o, a, d, g, m, l and l, see, my, to, go, this, is).

This week we will also continue to work on positional words (above, below, under, behind, in front) as we create a book– *Hide Turkey Hide!*

Math:

Our focus this week in math will be on the number 7. We will do all things 7 related. Students will be counting forwards and backwards to 7. They will count objects in groups of seven, saying only one number as they touch each object. We will use story mats to tell stories and begin learning the 7 facts (1 and 6 is 7, 2 and 5 is 7, etc.).
