#### Language Arts:

This week our focus is on the letter g (as in goat and guitar). We are also going to begin taking the letters we learned (c, o, a, d, g) and writing words (dog, doc, cod, etc.). We have been learning letter sounds in isolation and will now begin to put these sounds together to make words (this is called blending). Blending is the first step to becoming a reader!

Our sight word this week . . . **the**. It is important that your child learns to recognize these sight words. They are all words that are not pronounced the way they are spelled (you cannot sound them out). We practice <u>ALL</u> of our sight words every day. You can help your child with these sight words by practicing them at home. Our list to date includes **I**, see, like, go, to, my, the.

### Math:

Our focus this week in math will be on the number 5. We will do all things 5 related. Students will be counting forwards and backwards to 5. They will count objects in groups of five, saying only one number as they touch each object. We will use story mats to tell stories and begin learning the 5 facts (1 and 4 is 5, 2 and 3 is 5, etc.).
