Language Arts:

This week we will begin reviewing colors. We will read and retell lots of stories about colors including *Brown Bear, Brown Bear* by Eric Carle and *Pete the Cat– I Love My White Shoes* by Eric Litwin. Students will create their own version of these stories to practice reading and writing their color words.



Math:

In math this week, we will be sorting objects . . . including ourselves. We will also learn about the defining properties of shapes (number of sides, etc.) and have an opportunity to sort shapes. As we work to launch our math centers students will have the opportunity this week to explore different math manipulatives. We started this exploration last week with unifix cubes. The students will be introduced to pattern blocks, treasure boxes, and geoboards.
